### **Highlights :**

The Grand River's hiking and biking trail network is part of the Trans-Canada Trail, the longest trail in the world. The 16,000 kilometer Trans-Canada Trail enters the Grand River watershed through the Elora Cataract Trailway in the north, and links the communities of Guelph, Fergus, Elora, Elmira, Kitchener, Waterloo, Cambridge, Paris, Brantford, Caledonia and Dunnville.

### **Itinerary :**

Leaving Langdon Hall, we bike at a leisurely pace on the beautiful trail alongside the Grand River from Cambridge to Paris. After savoring a delicious picnic lunch you'll get set up with a canoe and safety gear by our friends and certified guides at Grand Experiences.

Then you will take off on this easy-going canoe journey with stops to explore stone ruins of an 18<sup>th</sup> century mill along the forested riverbank, an optional hike up the Spottiswood Bluff to enjoy the spectacular river view, and to check out the scenic Spring Island where some interesting springs join the river.

After traveling through some rare and beautiful Carolinian forests, you arrive in Paris - a 19<sup>th</sup> Century town on the Grand River known as "The Prettiest Town in Canada". There our shuttle awaits you to bring you back to Langdon Hall, just in time for a well deserved spa-treatment... Now how about that ?!
